- 1 In situations where a broker is employed by a third party, subsection 111.36(a) provides that the broker must transmit to the "actual importer"\*, either a copy of its bill for services and / or a copy of the entry unless the actual importer waives in writing receipt of either or both of these documents; and
- 2 In cases where the broker is sharing its fees with a forwarder and is billing the forwarder, the broker must transmit a copy of its bill directly to the importer or "other party in interest"\*\*, unless waived in writing by the importer or other party in interest.
- \* The term "actual importer" is not defined but we believe that it may be assumed that it means the same as "ultimate consignee" on the C.F. 7501 (ie the broker's customer).
- \*\* If the broker acts as the importer, "other party in interest" would again mean the brokers' customer.
